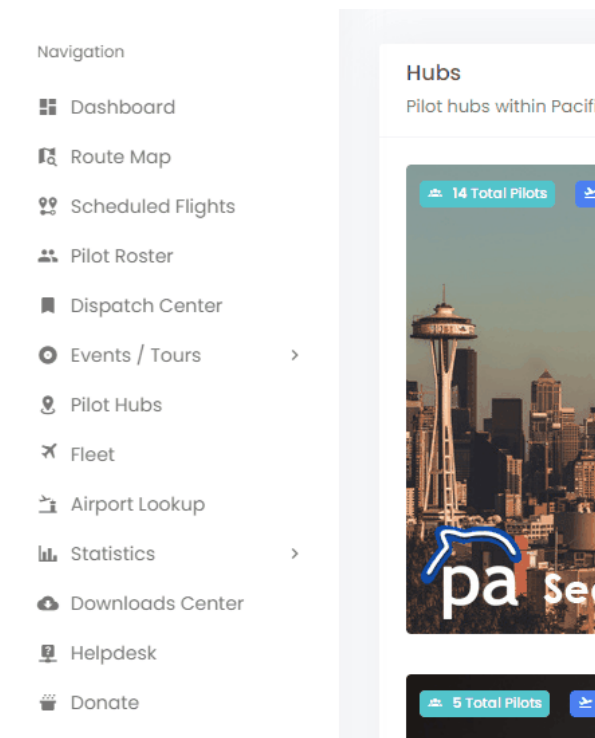


Tours & Events

Pilots earn awards and additional XP in participating in them.

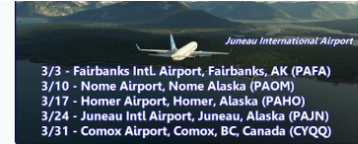
To join an event or tour, you can visit **Events / Tours** section of the crew center.



You can choose which area you would like to visit.

In this example we are going to join an event, click on **Events** then you can choose which event to join to bring up the event details.

Fly all the destinations in order to receive the March perfect attendance award and 50 experience points. In order to count, each leg has to be dispatched from this page. Click to view the leg you intend to fly, then choose Dispatch the flight from that page. You can't just randomly fly to these destinations. In order to count toward the award, the flights must be dispatched from this page and flown in order. Just a reminder, the flights are open all month. If you don't fly Vatsim Sundays or you miss out on a Sunday flight, you can make up the flight anytime during the month. Enjoy..

If it is an event generally it will be **Fly In / Out** based on what the **Dep & Arr** shows, if they show **Any** this means anywhere.
